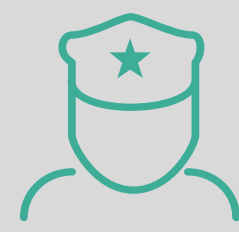

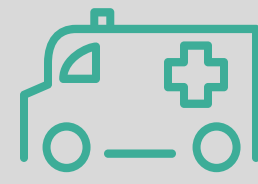

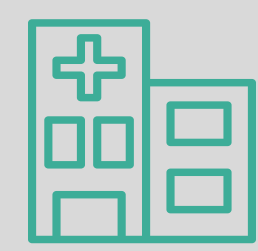
Police-recorded family violence incidents

Family violence ambulance attendances

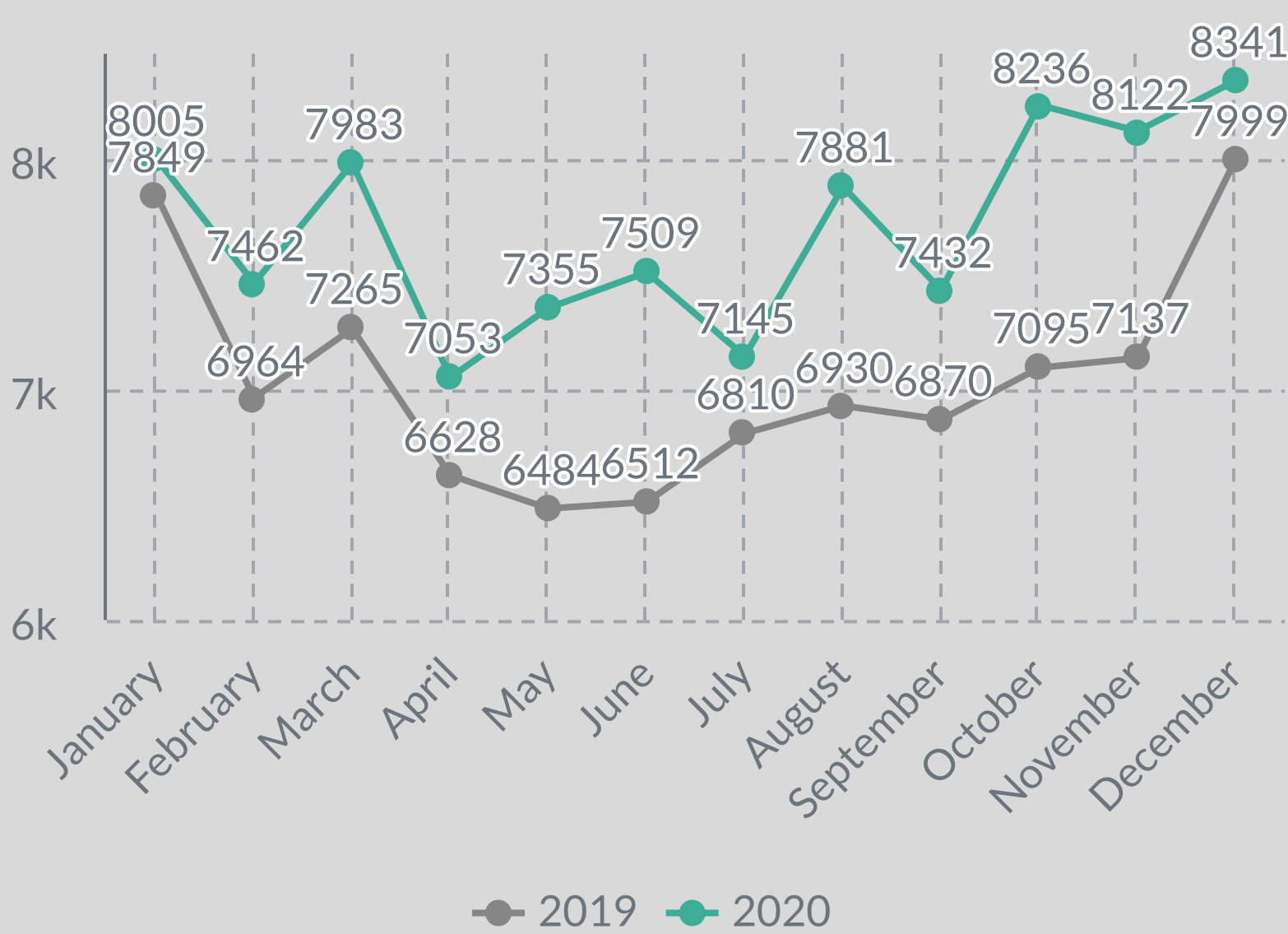

## Police-recorded incidents and offences



Throughout 2020, more family violence incidents were recorded by Victoria Police than in 2019. Overall, there were 7,981 more police attended family violence incidents in 2020 than 2019, which represents a 9.4% increase.

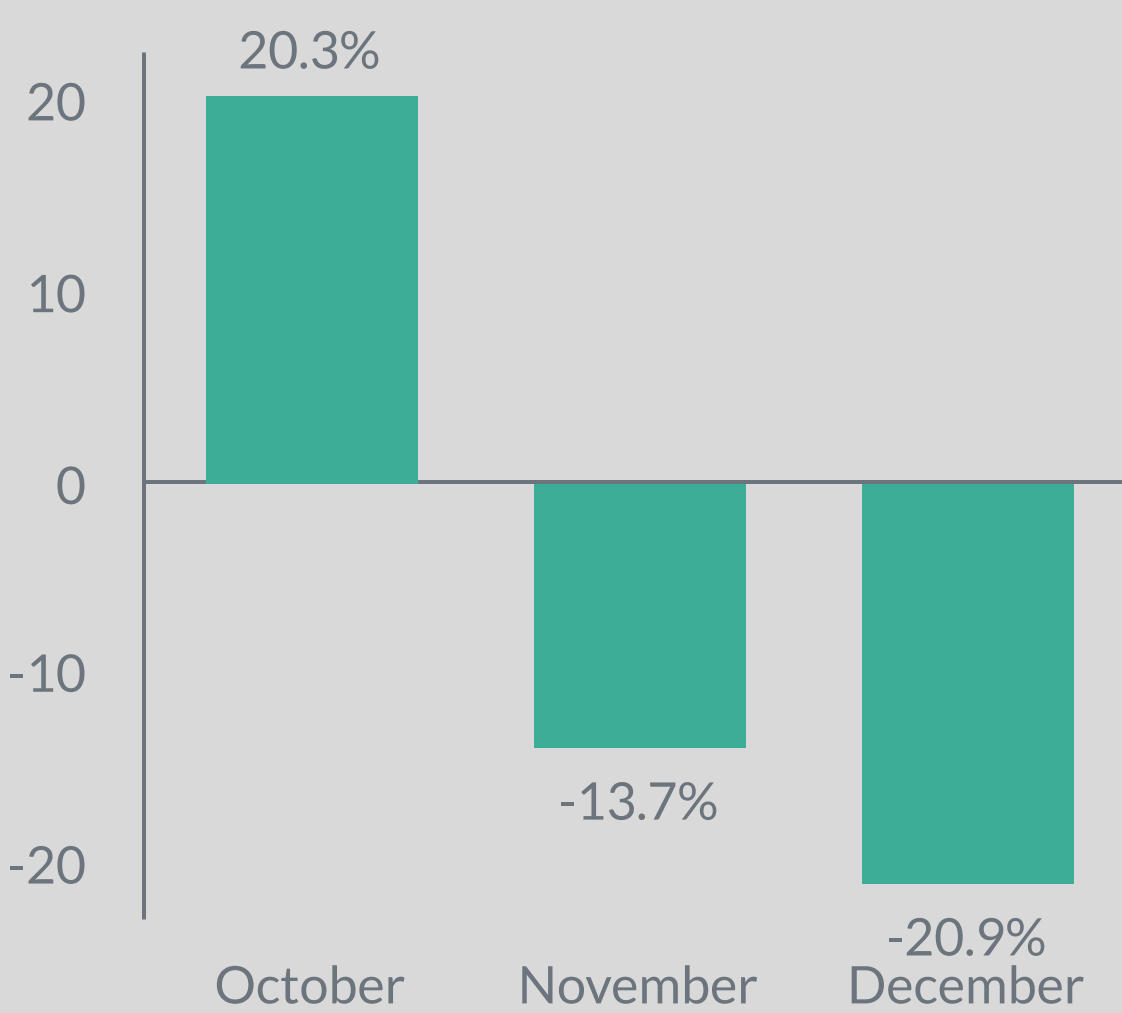

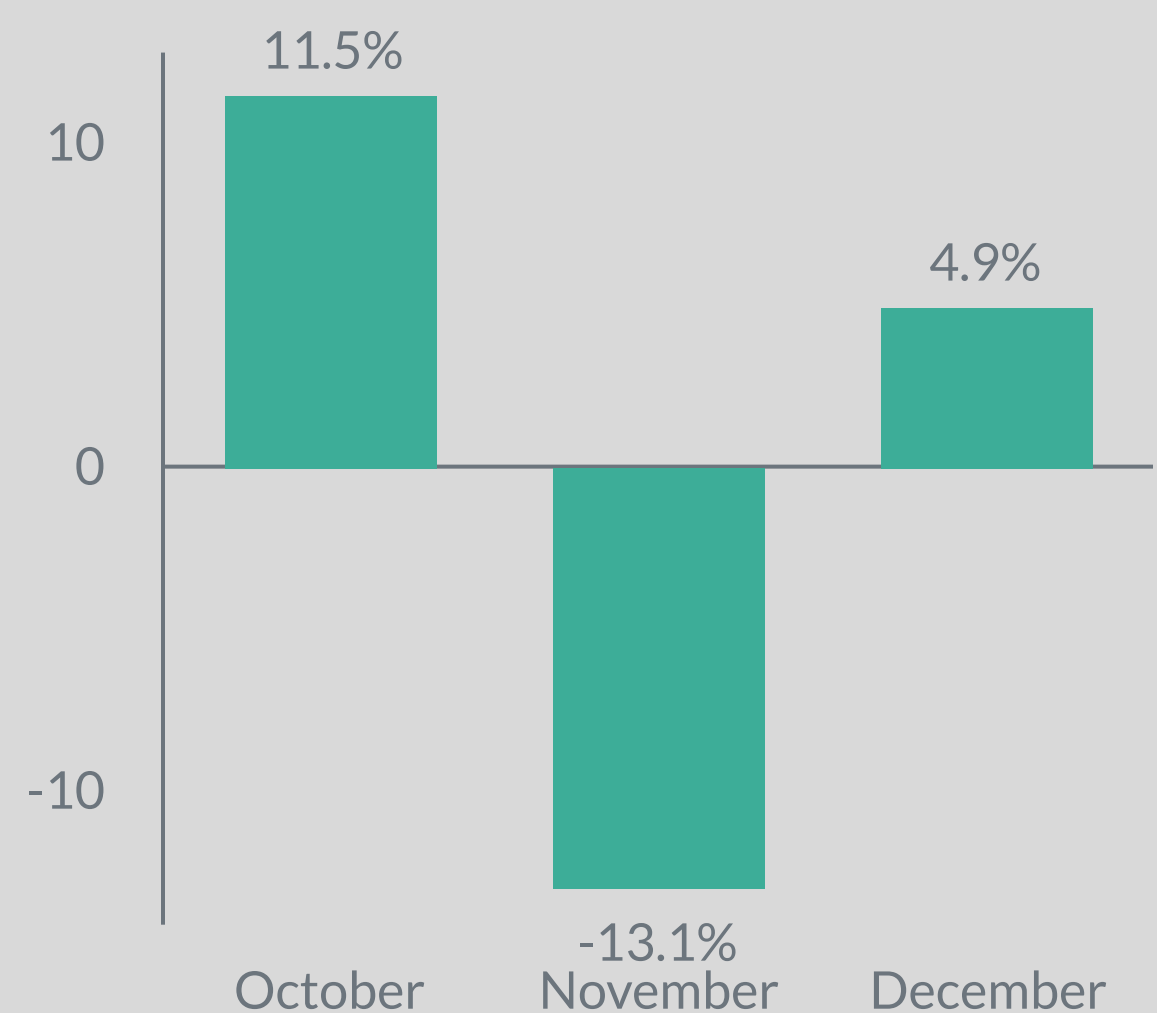

% change in FV related ambulance attendances - Q4 2019 to Q4 2020

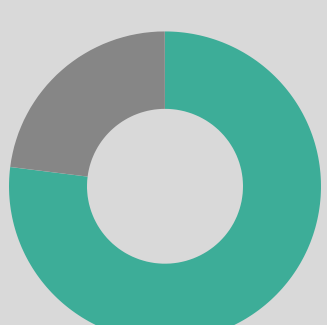


% change in FV related ED attendances - Q4 2019 to Q4 2020

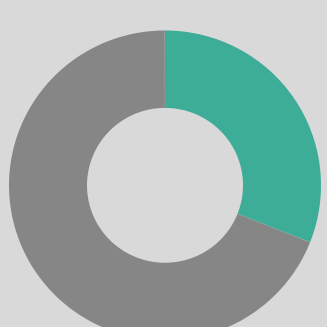

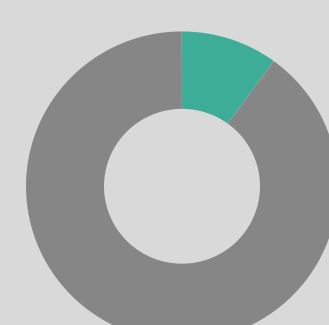

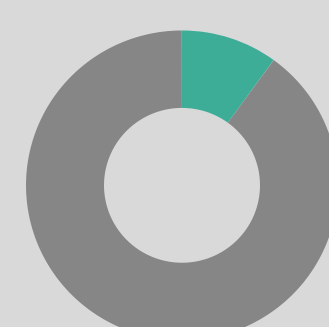
