

# Breach of COVID-19 restrictions in Victoria, March-June 2020

Police recorded **6,062** breach of COVID-19 restriction offences between March and June 2020



Close to 1 in 3 offences occurred between midnight and 6am



662 offences occurred in Melbourne city ... the highest number of any local government area



Almost 1 in 5 offences were committed over the Easter long weekend (April 10-13)



58% of offences occurred on the street or footpath ... while 14% were in a house or apartment



The holiday destinations of Corangamite and Colac-Otway had the highest rate of offences per 100,000 population of any local government area

## Breach of COVID-19 restriction offenders

Police recorded **5,474** individual people for breaching COVID-19 restriction offences between March and June 2020



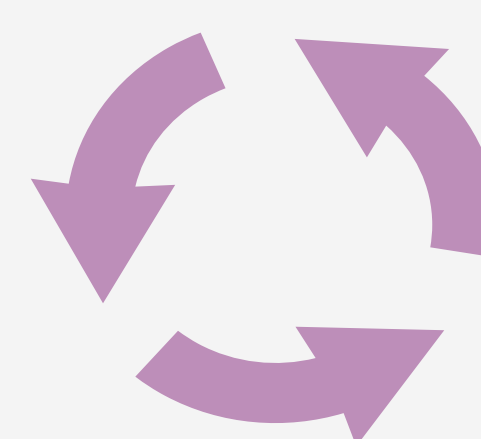
29.5 was the average (mean) age of offenders



1 out of 4 offenders were female, while three-quarters were male

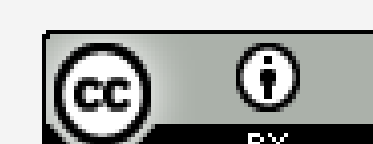


65% had previously been recorded as an offender prior to their first breach of COVID-19 restriction



10% were recorded for more than one breach of COVID-19 restriction
